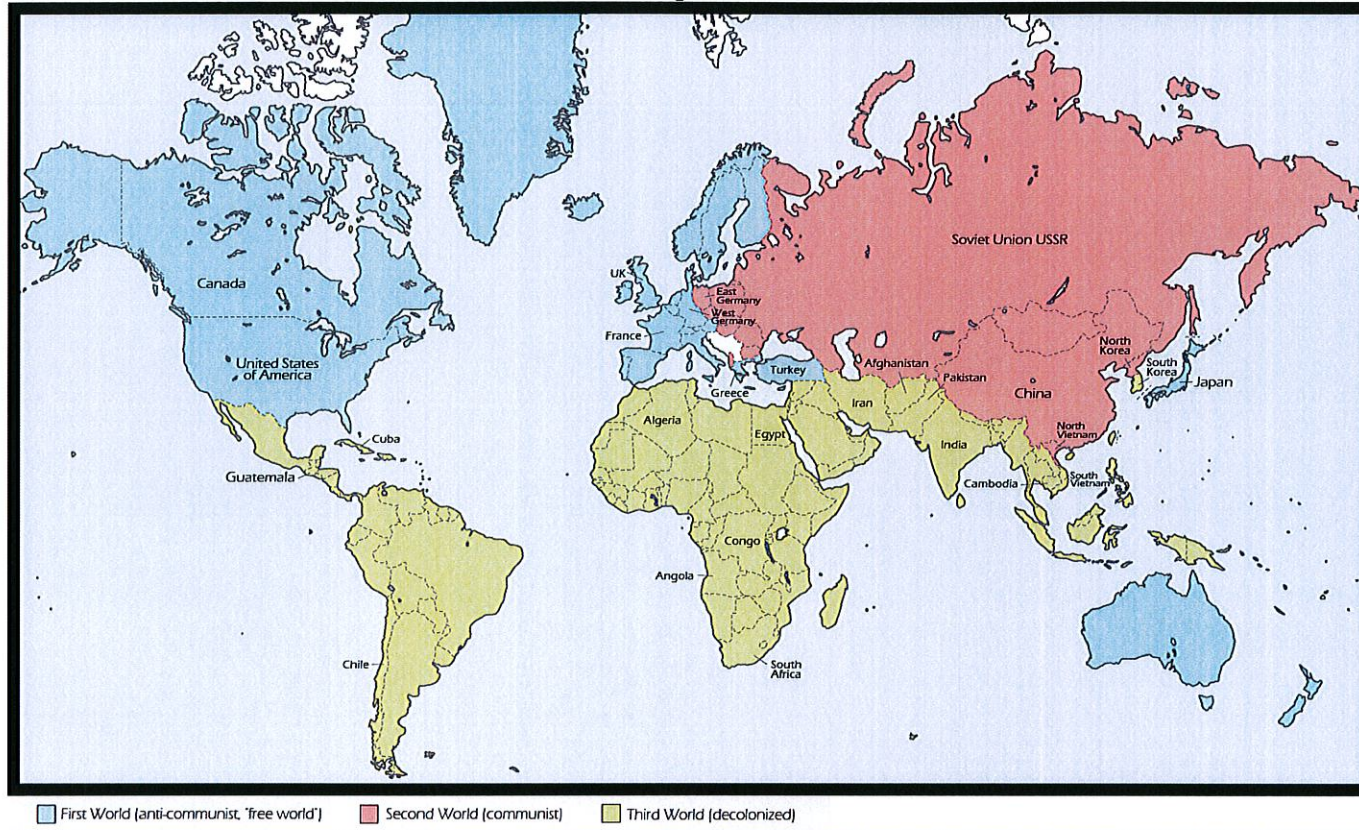


CWW2.2.9 Decolonization through Maps (Three World Order, again)

	<h2>The Soviet Way</h2>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Oppose imperialism and support self-determination • Spread communism and economic equality • Support communist parties abroad • Protect the Soviet Union
	<h2>The Third Way</h2>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Oppose colonialism and dependence on former imperialists • Avoid copying European/Western ideas • Develop industrial economies • End racism • Pursue non-alignment
